Prerequisites

Before installing ClustrixDB, you will need:

- The ClustrixDB installer and a license key. If you do not yet have either of these, please contact [Clustrix Sales](#).
- Servers (on-premise or in the cloud) running CentOS or RHEL 7.4. For system requirements see [ClustrixDB Reference Server Configurations](#).
- root or sudo privileges to install ClustrixDB. As part of installation, you can configure users to run and manage the database process.
